# HERRINGBONE DESIGNED BY EVORICH IN SINGAPORE

### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

DISCLAIMER: ACTUAL METHOD OF INSTALLATION MAY VARY DEPENDING ON TERRITORIES OF INSTALLATION.

# HERF HERRINGBONE® INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**NOTE:** Separate HERF Herringbone® A and B panels (as shown in *Figure 1*) into 2 separate stacks before starting the installation. Check both panels for any transport damage before starting. It is best for the HERF Herringbone® panels to be stored at site 24 hours before installation



### 1. Subfloor Preparation:

Clean the floor prior to installation by sweeping / vacuuming.

### 2. Installing HERF Herringbone®:

**Step 1:** Start the installation on the left side of a wall. Lay an A panel on the floor with its long side facing the wall and place it at an angle of 45 degrees (*Figure 2*). The distance between the left wall and nearest point of the A panel must be less than the longer side of one HERF Herringbone® panel.



**Step 2:** Next, connect the B panel to the A panel. To do this, slightly angle the long side of the B panel against the short side of the previously installed A panel. Click the A and B panels together to lock them tightly together. Ensure it by tapping with a mallet at the joints.

Make sure that both grooves of the A and B HERF Herringbone® panels form a continuous line.



**Step 3:** Make a row of this pattern starting with the long side of the A panel clicked together with the short side of the previously installed B panel **(Figure 4).** Continue this process with as many panels as may fit along the starting wall.



Step 4: Center the first wall row of HERF Herringbone® panels along the starting wall (blue walls).



The distance of the first and last panels to both sides of the wall must be less than the length of one panel.

**Step 5:** Measure and cut the end panels using a pen knife but leave a gap of 3-5mm to each wall to allow space for expansion.



Next, begin the second row with an A panel. Click together and fold down to secure the connection *(Figure 6)*.

Step 6: From left to right, continue installing the A panels in the second row (Figure 7).



**Step 7:** From right to left, finish the second row by clicking the B panels together. Finish this row by cutting a piece of panel cut to size (Step 5).



**Step 8:** Complete 4 rows by repeating steps 5 to 7. Measure, mark, and then cut the first four rows to achieve a cut parallel to the blue wall. Move the cut panels along the blue wall **(Figure 9)**.



**Step 9:** Install a few more rows by following steps 5 to 7. Put in spacers between the HERF Herringbone® panels and walls to ensure an expansion gap of 3 to 5mm (Figure 10).



**Step 10:** For the last row, measure, mark, and then cut the panels to size. Remove spacers and cover the expansion gaps with skirting boards and/or trimmings OR use silicone to fill up the gaps for a skirting-free finish.


